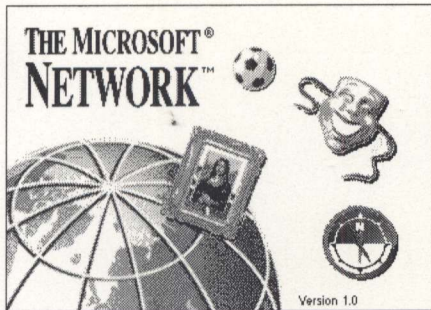


# Your **Windows 95** Preview provides free access to The **Microsoft Network**.



## Introducing The Microsoft Network

The Microsoft Network is Microsoft's online service and, as a participant of the Windows 95 Preview Program, you are

eligible to test it for the duration of the Preview Program. This gives you a unique opportunity to explore MSN during its final stages of development and be the first to experience new content and services that are added each day. Also, you can help shape MSN by providing us your feedback.

### FREE OF CHARGE!

There is no charge to use The Microsoft Network during the preview program. However, when you sign on the service, you will be prompted for a valid credit card number. Please enter it. *Nothing will be billed to your card during this period.* Information on pricing and policies will be sent to you before we begin actual billing. At that time you will be able to select a subscription and payment plan, or terminate your Microsoft Network account.

### Highlights of The Microsoft Network

**Email!:** Communicate via electronic mail with other MSN members or with anyone who has an Internet email address.



Computers and Software

**Bulletin Boards!:** There are hundreds of bulletin boards to explore and participate in on MSN. Discuss everything from movie reviews to PC technical issues hosted by topic experts.

**Information!:** Get the latest news, sports, and weather. Also, participate in exchanging ideas and information with various special interest groups on MSN, i.e. music, gardening, movies, etc...



Education and Reference

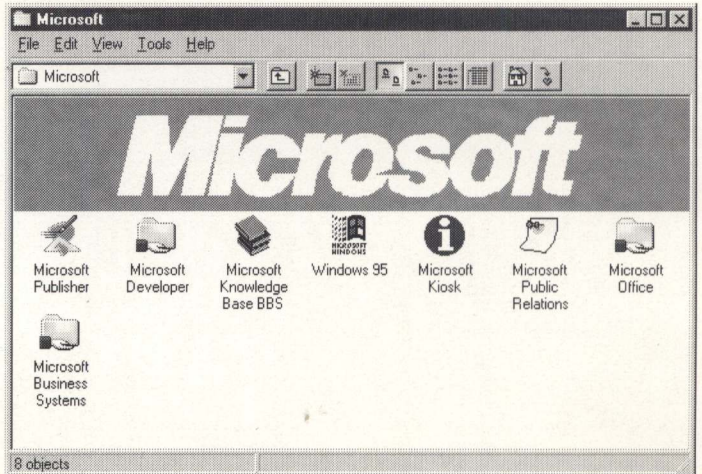
**File Download Libraries!:** Explore the various download libraries available on MSN containing useful shareware, graphics, utilities, etc... - all available for you to copy to your PC.



Science and Technology

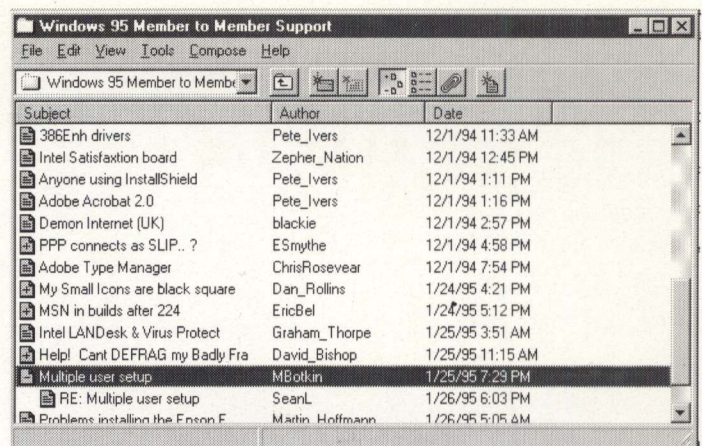

## Connecting to The Microsoft Network

MSN makes joining the world of electronic information and communication easy for any Windows 95 user. If you did not choose "The Microsoft Network" as an installation option during Windows 95 Setup, start your computer using Windows 95 and follow these instructions:

1. Have your Windows 95 installation diskettes/CD-ROM ready
2. From the Start button, choose "Settings"/"Control Panel"
3. In Control Panel, double-click the "Add/Remove Programs" icon.

4. Select the "Windows Setup" tab, check "The Microsoft Network" from the list and click "OK".
5. Insert appropriate Windows 95 installation diskettes or CD-ROM.
6. Once installation is complete, click "The Microsoft Network" icon on the desktop and follow instructions.
